In Australia, three processing methods are commonly used for extracting oil-cold pressed, expeller and the solvent method. Each method has an impact on the nutritional characteristics of the canola meal. Cold pressing tends to leave a higher oil content in the meal whereas solvent extraction meals contain less oil and a higher protein concentration.

Benefts

Canola Meal offers the following features and benefits.

Excellent source of protein, fibre and energy stimulating dry matter intake. Canola Meal contains high levels of crude protein, fibre and energy. The high level of ruminant by-pass protein acts to stimulate dry matter intake. This is particularly effective for improving pasture utilisation and milk production in dairy rations.

Desirable amino acid profile. Canola Meal offers desirable amino acid profile making it an ideal inclusion in most animal diets.
