Peas & Beans Co-Product

Peas and beans are a co-product of food manufacture.

They provide a safe and palatable feeding option through November to February. Naturally high in digestible energy and Rumen degradable protein, Castlegate James Greens offer a high value feed at times where pasture quality is usually decreasing or silage is being cut.

Castlegate James Greens can be fed straight to dairy cows and are suitable for feeding on a feed pad or direct into a paddock for grazing. Having moderate NDF% means cows can physically eat high levels of a high value feed and as such help maintain cow condition and are direct drivers of milk production.

Ideally stored in a bunker, but can be tipped directly in a silage pit or paddock, Castlegate James Greens have a shelf life of around 8-14 days. As such your Castlegate James representative will set up an allocation to ensure consistent, fresh supply of product to optimize all feed coming on farm. Castlegate James Greens are a prefect companion feed to be fed alongside pasture or any other feeds you have on farm. They can also be used to extend pasture round as a direct replacement for pasture if required.



Feeding guide

Peas and Beans is only suitable for ad-lib feeding when Castlegate James guide lines are followed.
